**Specific Responsibilities: Education** 

# To deliver quality Education and Training courses and programmes to a high standard leading on content and resource development – focus on Teacher Training courses at all levels

- Work with the strategic management (CEO) to understand the needs of learners and create
  and implement robust teacher trainer related courses to address both short and long term
  requirements with a focus on addressing any skills gaps and meeting the needs of our
  members. Developing new courses and materials
- Design, prepare and deliver Education and Training courses to meet observation requirements including Ofsted
- Learn all current courses within the HCPA Leadership Suite to provide emergency cover
- Lead on mapping all courses to appropriate qualifications and standards and manage all quality assurance within the department in line with QA team.

## To provide direction and mentoring for the Education Department

 Line Manage Practice Educators & Tutors and manage the day to day utilisation of Practice Educators, Tutors & Freelance trainers to ensure all courses are covered by appropriate staff and manage emergency cover when necessary

- Ensure all lesson planning and schemes of work are up to date
- Act as an assessor and verifier for education related courses
- Collect and monitor feedback on the training team

#### To build sustainable and innovative Education Programmes

- Instigate new innovative ideas for the education department and drive forward the HCPA education offer
- Develop membership **surveys** for Education (LNA) and manage results
- **Network** with external sector bodies and sector specific groups to share knowledge and represent HCPA's interests.
- Ensure there is a strong link between the Education Department and the Recruitment Department around such areas as care certificate and conversion courses
- Provide presentation input for meetings and events
- Hold key accountability and write up project **reports** and add input to tenders

### To build commercial (and funded) education programmes (non care specialist)

- Grow the commercial course area of the business brining in new ideas to meet members' needs
- Engage and build relationships with staffing agencies to bring in further work for HCPA
- Work with Associate members (in other counties) to sign up courses and delegates
- Collect and monitor feedback and produce reports on each commercial endeavour

#### **To Manage Education Budgets**

- Manage Education Budgets by budget monitoring monthly
- Work with the finance team to cost all courses whether funded or unfunded
- Agree contracts with **freelancers** and ensure timely payment

# To work deliver Education and some business/leadership courses

- Deliver on Leadership Courses
- Delivering Award in Education and Training, Certificate in Education and Training, Assessor and IQA awards, Delivering Training and Peer Educator
- Emergency Cover

To work on the teaching facility project as part of the wider leadership team
