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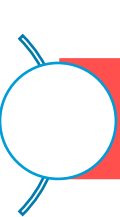

- Ensure safe discharge, stepping down or transfer of patients with urinary catheters
- Systemwide ongoing communication
- Catheter Passport

3. UTI Prevention



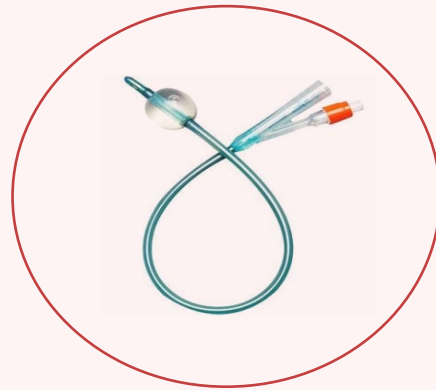
- Improving hydration

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Summary from the UTI and Urinary Catheter Project

Costly to the NHS and to the patient i.e. unplanned appointments and hospital admissions

Risk of Catheter Associated Urinary Tract Infections (CAUTI), which could lead to blood stream infections

Catheter passport as the main starting point towards prevention

Other initiatives such as local Hydration projects are vital

Raising awareness, Education and Training

Guidance, policies and support

Antimicrobial Resistance Issues

Catheter reviews, and follow-ups (e.g., TWOCS, removal & ongoing care)
