

Provision of Reablement Services Tender

Hertfordshire County Council's Commissioning for Older People Team has launched a tender opportunity to deliver Reablement Services.

Reablement is a person-centred, strengths-based approach that supports Individuals aged 18 and over to develop, regain or maintain the skills, confidence and independence needed to live the life they choose and participate in activities that are important to them. The Services will focus on enabling Individuals to maximise their own abilities, strengths and assets, building resilience and promoting wellbeing rather than creating dependency.

Services are delivered short-term, usually up to 4 weeks, working towards SMART goals to maximise independence and reduce long-term need.

The Services are being tendered in 11 geographic Lot areas. There will be one Reablement Services Provider per Lot area.

In order to bid for these contracts, bidders will need to be registered with the Care Quality Commission (CQC) and have been operational for two years delivering Reablement or enabling focussed Support Services to those aged 18 and over. Bidders will need either a CQC or PAMMS rating of Good or above, and will need to meet minimum turnover thresholds.

The tender submission deadline is 12 noon on Thursday 8th October 2026, with new contracts due to go live 1st April 2027.
