

Compassionate

Compassionate Neighbours offers emotional and social support for people living with a serious or terminal illness and are who experiencing loneliness or social isolation.

Volunteers are trained by Peace Hospice Care and then matched with a local community member based on hobbies, interests and geography in the hope to grow genuine friendships.

Compassionate Neighbours can support Community Members by:

- visiting regularly
- offering friendship, emotional support and a listening ear
- helping them to do the things they like doing
- helping them stay connected to the community as well as family and friends.

Referral criteria for Community Member:

- must have a life-limiting illness
- must live within the Watford, Three Rivers and Hertsmere area
- must be socially isolated and/or in need of extra emotional/social support
- may have carers/family who need extra emotional support.
