We aim to see housebound patients at home within two hours and prevent hospital admissions. Every vehicle is crewed by an Urgent Care Practitioner and a member of the social team.

What we can do

- Clinical assessment with medications
- Care for falls without injury or with minor wounds
- Support with poor mobility (stuck in chair or bed) and mobility aids
- Support for Carers/Family who are struggling to cope
- Emergency care packages
- Onward referral to other Prevention of Admission teams

What we can't see

- Acutely unwell or injury needing hospital assessment, chest pain and difficulty in breathing
- Stroke symptoms•
- Fall involving hitting head and on blood thinners
- Acute mental health crisis
- Loss of consciousness
