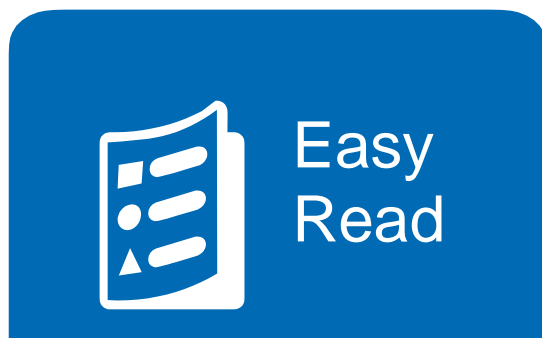

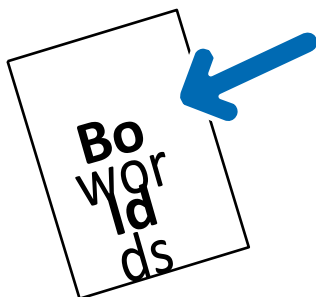

Oliver McGowan was a young man with autism and a learning disability. Oliver sadly died because staff who cared for him did not have the skills and knowledge to look after him.



The Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training will help staff know how to give the best care to autistic people and people with learning disabilities.

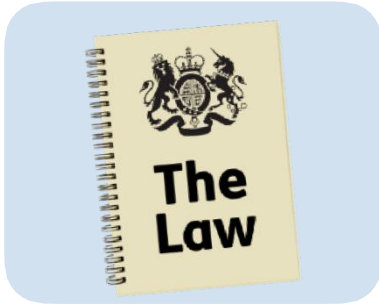
