







## How does the flu jab work?

The flu jab is an injection and is the best way to protect you against getting really ill with flu. If you don't want to have an injection then it can be given by a spray in your nose instead.

The injection is better though.









- After you have had the injection you might have a sore arm or feel a bit achy or have a fever for a day or two.
- The flu injection **CANNOT** give you the flu.



• If you are unwell on the day of your injection then wait until you are better before having the flu jab.

Always speak to your doctor **BEFORE** having any injection, especially if you have never had it before or are allergic to eggs.
