 <b>End of Life</b>	Provides support for service users and professionals to help avoid unnecessary or unwanted hospital admissions	<b>CALL 01462 679540</b> Garden House Hospice Advice Line 24 hours a day 7 days a week
 <b>Mental Health</b>	A resident experiencing a mental health problem for the first time or is in need of urgent help. <i>(If your resident is already using the service contact their case worker directly).</i>	<b>CALL 01442 275628</b> for informal advice  <b>CALL 0300 777 0707</b> for referral for new patient 24 hours a day 7 days a week
 <b>Integrated Care Team</b>	The team brings together nurses, physios, OTs, mental health nurses and social care staff.  Provides support for patients that are already on the case load who require clinical assistance e.g. blocked catheters, wound care  Or, if there is a risk of a hospital admission of a resident (nursing or residential resident)	<b>CALL 0300 123 7571</b> for same day urgent visits: 8am to 10pm, 7 days a week  Email <a href="mailto:hct.northhertsspoc1@nhs.net">hct.northhertsspoc1@nhs.net</a> for routine referrals
 <b>Wheelchair service</b>	Provides wheelchairs and equipment including pressure relieving cushions and some accessories for wheelchairs  *New users should be referred through their GP, district nurse, physiotherapist, occupational therapist.	<b>CALL 0333 234 0303</b>  8.00am to 5.00pm Mon-Fri <i>For current wheelchair users only</i>
	For life or limb threatening emergencies only (Chest Pain, FAST- stroke, Loss of Consciousness)	<b>CALL 999</b>  24 hours a day, 7 days a week
