




Mandatory Requirements

Job offer

Be paid a minimum salary Home Office approved sponsor


English requirement Speak English at the intermediate level at B1

Skill level Do a job that's on the list of eligible occupations



Skilled Worker Visa

Every applicant must score at least **70 points** to be eligible for the skilled worker route. **50 of these points** must come from meeting the **mandatory** criteria and **20 from tradable criteria**.



Skilled Worker Route: Nurse (band 5)

Ava wants to come to the UK to work and has been offered a job as a qualified nurse (band 5) for a salary of £24,907. She meets all the mandatory requirements under the points-based immigration system.

Ava must now score a further 20 points to be eligible for the Skilled Worker route. Her salary is below the general threshold of £26,200 but, as **nurses are a listed health job**, and Ava's salary meets the **national pay scale in England** (and is above £20,960 or £10.75 / 37.5hr week), and she scores 20 points for her salary, meeting the total requirement of 70 points.

Public Sector occupations will use national pay scales to determine the going rate. They will not have access to tradeable points.

Health & Care Worker Visa

Be a qualified doctor, nurse, health professional or adult social care professional

Work in an eligible health or social care job

Work for a UK employer that's been approved by the Home Office

Have a 'certificate of sponsorship' from your employer

Be paid a minimum salary

Health & Care Visa: Care Worker

Alisha wants to come to the UK to work and has been offered **a job as a Care** Worker for £10.75 per hour, based on a 37.5 hour working week.

The job is offered by an approved sponsor, it is an eligible job under the Health and Care visa, and she meets the English language requirement of at least B1.

As Care Workers are now a designated occupation on the shortage occupation list, Alisha will score the further 20 points needed to meet the requirements of the Health and Care visa under the points-based system.

Student Visa: Permitted Activities

Study on the course of study with the student sponsor which assigned the Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies

Work as a Student- Union sabbatical officer

Undertake work related to a work placement, assessed as an integral part of the course

Undertake paid employment for 20 hours per week on a full-time course at degree level study or above or 10 hours per week_on a full-time course below degree level

Becoming a Licensed Sponsor

Check your organisation is eligible Ensure your organisation can manage its licence




Sponsor a worker – 15Days*

Check the people you want to hire are eligible to come to the UK under the points-based-system and fulfil all the necessary criteria Appoint people to manage the sponsorship process when you apply. Ensuring that your company stays compliant and keeps accurate records The fee is dependent on the type of licence you are applying for and the size of your business. It will either be £536 or £1476

You must follow the process of Issuing a certificate of sponsorship & paying the Immigration skills charge. Your employee may then make a visa application. If granted they can travel to the UK to work
